FEATURED CHARACTER BREAKDOWN

CAMPBELL: Character is female-presenting. Caucasian or any ethnicity. A kind and sincere high school senior, who slips easily in and out of a cheerleader persona and possesses an innate intelligence. Being captain of the squad means everything to her. A natural-born leader, but can be easily flustered. Pop/rock singer, good belt range. G3-F5. Significant dance/cheerleading skills a plus.

BRIDGET: Character is female-presenting. Caucasian or any ethnicity. Insecure, nerdy high schooler with a heart of gold. An energetic optimist, she blossoms into confidence over the course of the story. Great singer with R&B and riffing skills. Range: A3-F5. Dance/cheerleading skills a plus.

DANIELLE: Character is female-presenting. Black or any ethnicity. The Queen Bee of Jackson High School; dominating, and complicated. Head of the talented dance crew. Has an infectious sense of humor behind a composed mask. Loyal to her friends. Determined to get a scholarship in order to strive for a successful future. Strong belt. Range: F#3-F5. Significant dance/cheerleading skills a plus.

RANDALL: Character is male-presenting. Any ethnicity. Senior at Jackson High School. Campbell's developing love interest. Cute, alternative, an expert DJ with an easy confidence. Wise beyond his years. An old soul. Range: C#3-A4. Pop/rock tenor voice. No dance or cheer skills needed for this role.

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FEATURED CHARACTER BREAKDOWN

EVA: Character is female-presenting. Caucasian or any ethnicity. Incredibly like-able and sympathetic high school Freshman. Sweet and seemingly fragile. Joins the Truman squad – and turns out to be a sociopathic back-stabber who takes over the squad and complicates Campbell's life. (But we shouldn't see it coming!) Pop/rock voice. Range: A3-Eb5. Significant dance/cheerleading skills a plus.

SKYLAR: Character is female-presenting. Any ethnicity. A stereotypical bitchy cheerleader type-highly comedic, loyal to her friends, and not at all invested in her education. Range: G3-Gb5. Some dance/cheerleading skills a plus.

KYLAR: Character is female-presenting. Any ethnicity. A wanna-be Skylar. Very impressionable and seems to fit in only because of her skills of conformity. Constantly afraid of her individuality betraying her lack of coolness. A follower and one of Campbell's sidekicks. Range: G3-D5. Some dance/cheerleading skills a plus.

NAUTICA: Character is female-presenting. Latina, Black, or any ethnicity. Outgoing, comedic sidekick to Danielle; Sassy, loyal, and capable of aggression, when called for. Good singer with R&B and bluesy chops. Range: F3-Fb5. Significant dance/cheerleading skills a plus.

LA CIENEGA: Any gender to play a transgender feminine or nonbinary high school student. Latina, Black, or any ethnicity. BFFs with Nautica and Danielle. Has a wicked tongue but a generous spirit. Vocal range: D3-E5. Dance and cheerleading skills a plus.

TWIG: Character is male-presenting. Latino, Black, or any ethnicity. A funny and well-meaning flirt who develops an instant attraction to Bridget. Good singer with excellent hip-hop/rap skills. Range: Eb3-A4. Significant dance/cheerleading skills a plus.

STEVEN: Character is male-presenting. Caucasian or any ethnicity. A handsome, yet vapid puppy-dog who begins the show as Campbell's boyfriend. Well-meaning but easily manipulated. Good singer. Range: D3-Bb4. Dance/cheerleading skills a plus.

CAMERON: Character is male-presenting. Black or any ethnicity. One of the Jackson students, a hip-hop artist but even more into basketball. A semi-regular class clown and attempted ladies' man. Good singer. Range: Db3-G4. Dance/cheerleading skills a plus.
